## Message from the Executive Director



Summer is just days away, and the CIC plans to stay busy during this short season of sunshine. Many cities across the country are reopening, and the atmosphere has become safer due to Covid-19 guidelines and vaccine availability. Last week, CIC staff and board members traveled to Cumberland, MD to inspect and visit FCI Cumberland. The focus of our first on-site 2021 BOP inspection was healthcare availability and programming. A detailed report with facility and resident interview data is forthcoming. The CIC plans to inspect at least one more BOP facility this summer.

After the closure of Hope Village in April 2021, more than 200 DC residents were displaced to their homes or other halfway houses in the region. Volunteers of America (VOA) Residential Reentry Center (RRC) was the recipient of approximately fifty-one DC residents who are transitioning from BOP facilities. In November 2019, the CIC held virtual interviews with some of the DC population at VOA. DC residents were also mailed surveys to complete and return to the CIC. Lastly, a report updating findings regarding the provisions of the Youth Rehabilitation Act is forthcoming. Please regularly visit the CIC website to stay abreast of updates.

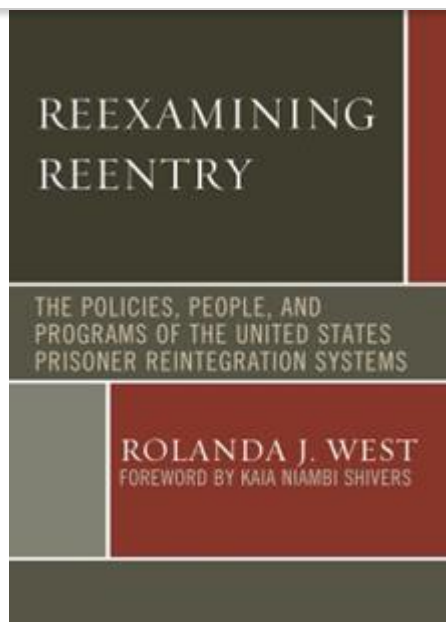
